For the power, for the protection, for the destiny, for the pride,

To our gods to our goddesses, hail”

Acknowledging our “Mother” and “Father” are important aspects of paganism, and this does not mean just our physical mother and father. Jord, mother earth herself is our mother, for we are nothing but a piece of nature ourselves. Of course, Odin (Spirit) is our father, and it just so happens they produced Thor together too. Knowing where we came

from and where we are going is a key, involving a faith around nature and concepts of reality and life.

Our “Sisters and our brothers” once again in dual meaning physically and metaphorically that all people have a piece of Odin in them and were created by nature of some sort. Therefore, by default we are one people, making us all brothers and sisters.

When the time comes and “Taking your place among them” is a code for destiny and fate.
